Sofia Cacciapaglia (b. 1983) is an Italian artist living in Milan, trained at the Accademia di Belle Arti di Brera. Her practice centers on painting, primarily large-scale oil works depicting female figures in suspended, dreamlike environments.

The representation of women lies at the core of her work: monumental yet ethereal figures inhabit metaphysical spaces where connection is expressed through gesture, touch, and silent exchange. Flowers often accompany these figures, acting as poetic extensions of the body and symbols of vitality and renewal. Soft forms, luminous palettes, and fluid compositions create a delicate balance between harmony and mystery, inviting a contemplative and immersive visual experience.
